



## **Home Repair and Private Rehabilitation Funds Available in the City of Medina and the City of Brunswick**

The City of Medina and the City of Brunswick, through the Community Housing Impact and Preservation Grant Program (CHIP), are now accepting applications for private home repairs and private home rehabilitations.

Funding is available for eligible low to moderate income residents for home repairs of approximately \$14,000 in the form of a grant and private home rehabilitation up to \$53,000 in the form of a partially forgivable no interest, no payment loan.
